Project Description







In & around Goa, there are lots of school dropouts. Thereafter they are lost in this world and either remain unemployed due to lack of education & skills or else get some small type jobs.

In order to provide these school dropouts with a platform of being skilled, we are providing them adequate vocational training viz courses in Electrical wiring, Plumbing, Hospitality (F&B, Housekeeping, Kitchen), Home Nursing, Aircontioning & refrigeration, Welding/fabrication, carpentary, etc.

As of now, under this concept there are 3 institutes in Goa. However these institutes lack the necessary training equipements for skill training which kind of hampers the total learning.

Also to get accrediated & cources certified by Govt. Departments, specific kind of equipements need to be in the institutes to facilitate the training. Only then will Govt. recognise the Vocational courses & the trainees.
