

## Satellite Clubs

One District 7030 e-club

Satellite clubs are intended as a temporary step on the way to becoming a full, independent Rotary club.



#### **SATELLITE CLUB**

- A short-term, transitional step on the path to becoming a full, independent Rotary club.
- No minimum/maximum number needed to start a Satellite club.
- Members = Rotarians and members of the sponsor club.
- Members pay the same Rotary dues as other Rotarians.
- Name: Rotary Satellite Club of Sponsor Club Name Additional Qualifier
- Set up their own board and have their own officers. However, instead of a president, a satellite club has a chair. The leadership of the Satellite club is not required to have a position on the board of the sponsor club, but it is highly recommended.
- Satellite club **determines its dues structure** and bylaws in collaboration with its sponsor club.
- Some or all of the members of a Rotaract club may form or join a Satellite club, as a transition to becoming a full Rotary club.



#### **DISTRICT 7030 E CLUB**


- A Rotary e-club is one that meets online but is otherwise similar to other Rotary clubs.
- As RI limited the number of e-clubs by 2 per district, **our DG** decided to accept the creation of one e-club to cover all the territories in our District named Rotary District 7030 E club.
- There is a minimum of 25 members to start a e-club.
- Members are Rotarians and pay the same Rotary dues.
- District 7030 e-club will set up its own board like a Rotary Club.
- The club **determines its dues structure** and bylaws in collaboration with its sponsor club.
- Our whish is to have the maximum of District 7030 Past Rotaractors who are not Rotarians to join the District 7030 e-club. They can join after a traditional Rotary club if they want.
