22 primary schools(incl. Pre- and Kindergarter in St.Patrick, St.Andrew and St. David.

Therefore the schools are being assessed, categorized and prioritized concerning their needs.

This project will have a tremendous impact on the overall functioning of the institutions.

## Emergency Water Supply Situation

Only 8 of the 22 schools have adequate emergency water supply.

At 14 schools there is insufficient volume or no tanks at all.

Students have to be sent home any time there is a shortage of water during dry season or any problems with the main pipe.

This happens 1-4 times in 6 month and it affects up to 3100 students.

## Sanitation - some examples

3 urinals for 148 boys

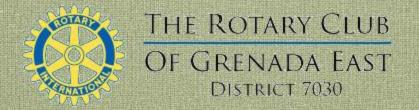
