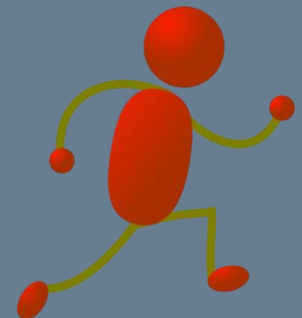

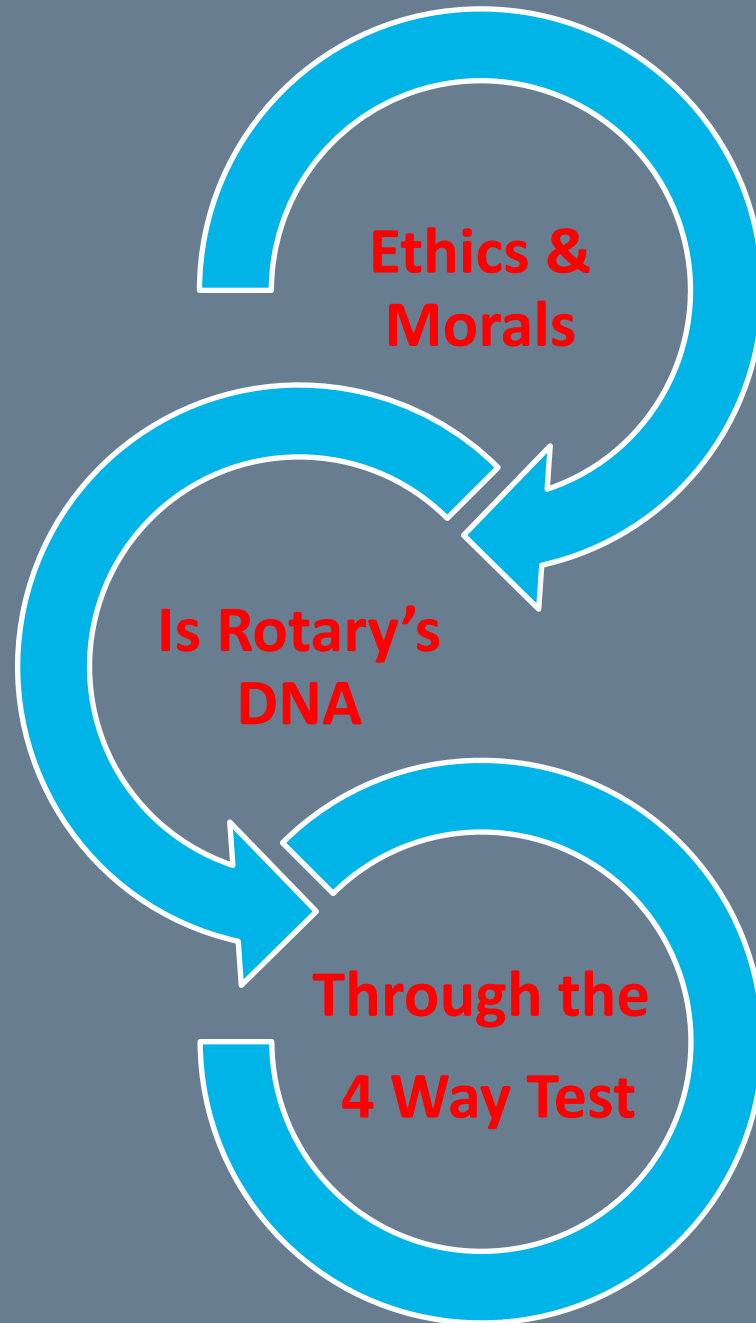
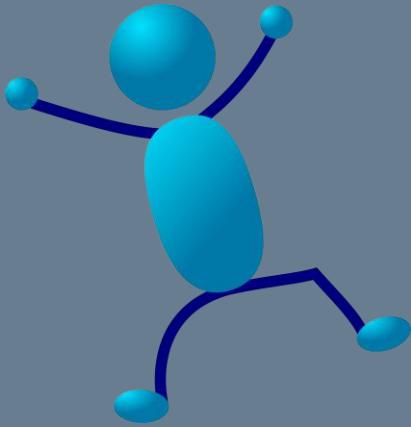
Ethics: Normally defined as the rules or standards governing the conduct of a person or professional persons

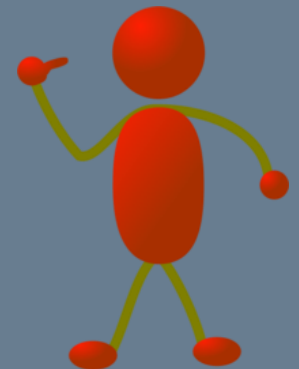
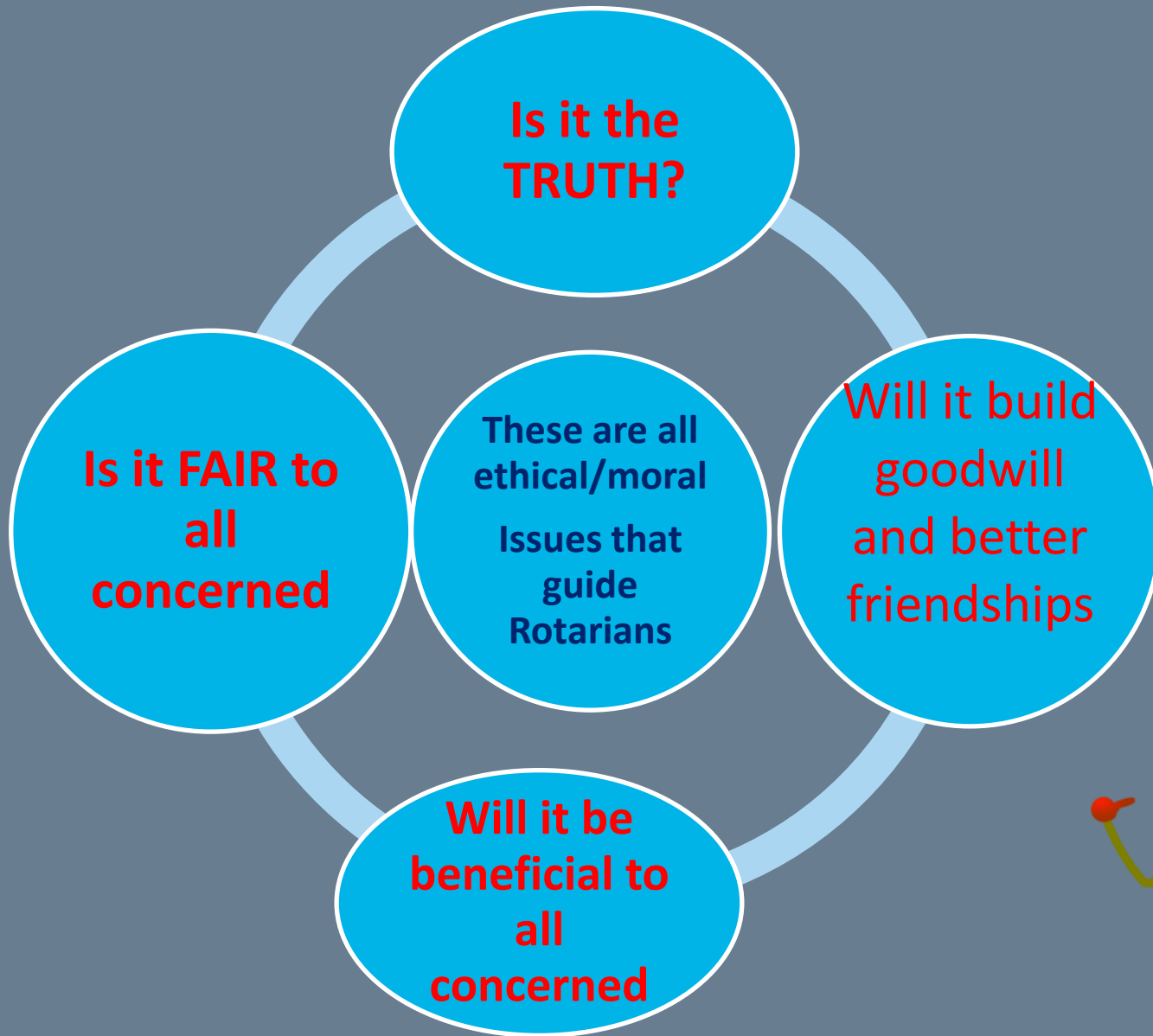
Morality: is defined as conformance to a recognized code, doctrine, or system of rules of what is right or wrong and to behave accordingly.

What is

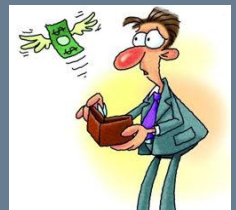
- The Company Accountant is dodgy about preparing financial statements, but is driving a new Ferrari

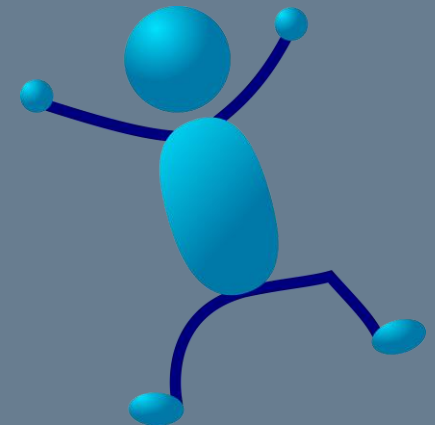
