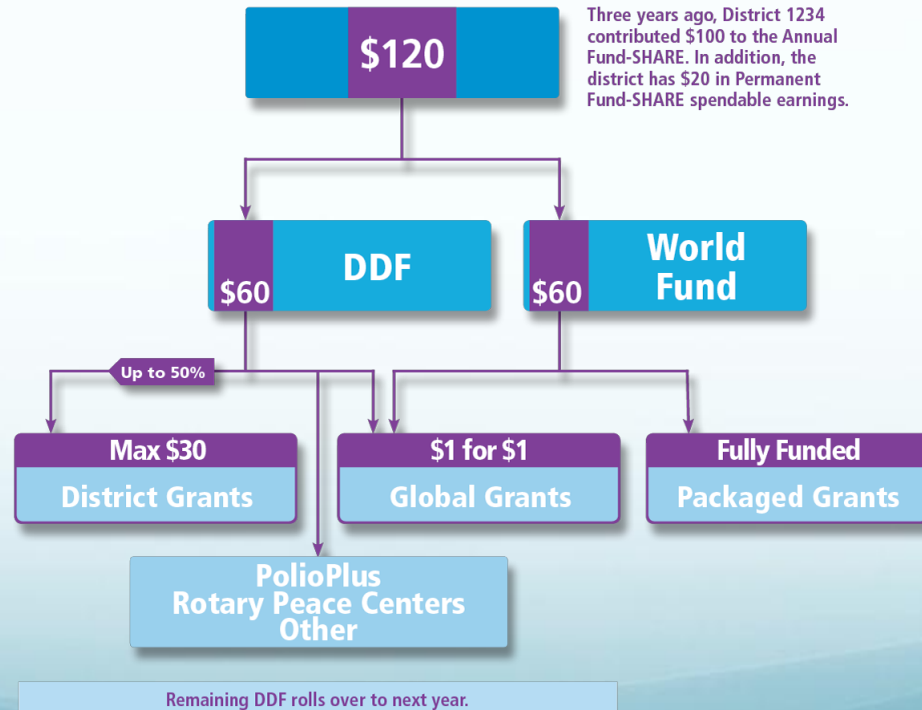
DISTRICT GRANTS

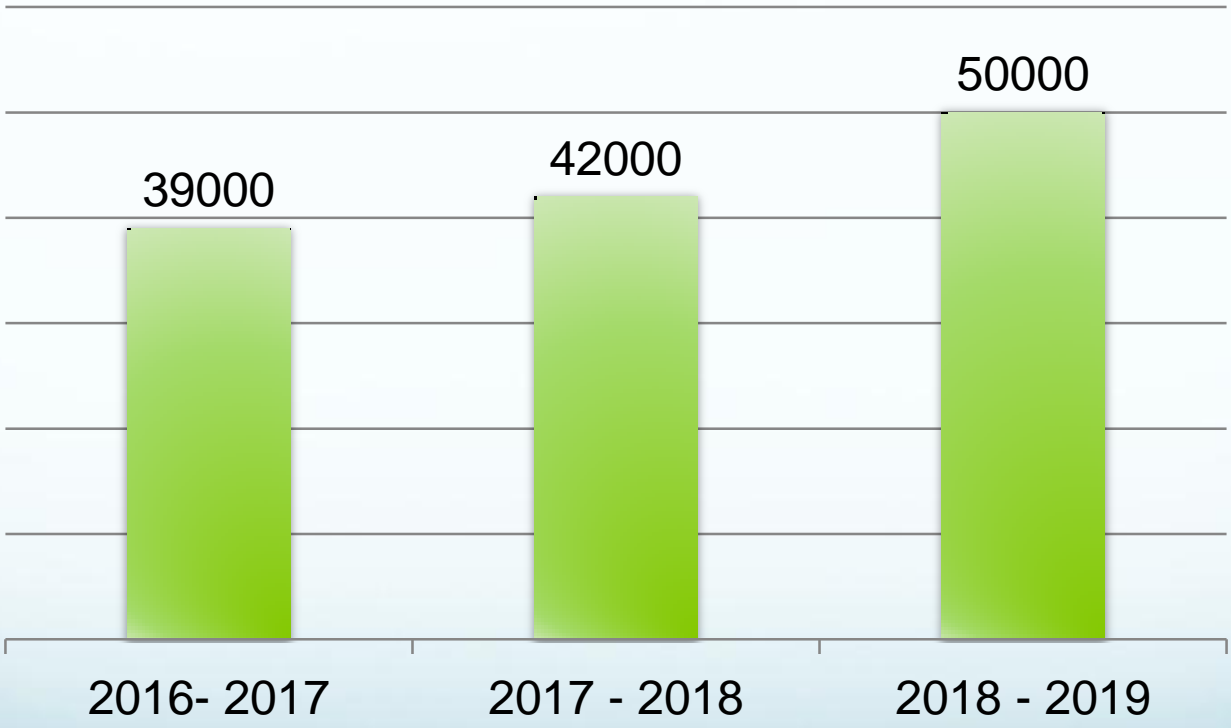
SHARE SYSTEM

PROTOCOL

ELIGIBILITY

- Club MOU to be signed by 30th June 2017
- Club has paid its RI & District dues
- Club is up to date on previous grant reporting
- Club has contributed to the Foundation over the last 3 years
- At least one member of the Club has attended a Grants Management Seminar
- The project is aligned to one of the [Six Areas of Focus](#)
- Club must have audited financial statements for the previous year
- Club has appointed a Rotary Foundation Chair before 1st July 2017 and reported it on Rotary Club Central
- Club has assigned Foundation goals before 1st July 2017 in Rotary Club Central
- Deadline for grant application – 30th September 2017

APPLICATION

- Submitted to PDG Milton Inniss
- Copied to PDG Hervé Honoré and the District Governor
- Assessment of application – no longer than 2 weeks
- Either accepted or declined and the Club will be informed
- Once accepted, the District Governor will sign the application
- Once all applications processed, the grant application is sent to The Rotary Foundation for approval and disbursement of funds.

MANAGEMENT

- Club must set up a separate bank account to receive and disburse the grant funds
- Primary contact person on the grant must report to the District every 3 months on the progress of the project
- Report in the form of photos, disbursements to date, progress and expected time for completion
- Final report to be 1 month after the completion of the project
- Copies of receipts and accounts showing the use of the funds
- Reporting is in US\$
- The District can ask for any information whatsoever to ensure that the funds are being used properly and for the purpose that they were intended
