HIGHLIGHTS FROM CLUB MEETING MARCH 07TH 2017

SUMMARY OF PRESENTATIONS

Secretary Martin's Presentation Secretary Martin gave a synopsis of the items discussed at the last Board Meeting held on February 16th, 2017.

Club Director PP Mark's Presentation

The new location for the Club's dinner meeting was discussed. It was expressed that the location is not in keeping with the identity of the club. PP Dennis gave a brief background to the history of the Club's various locations over the years and this was backed up by PDG Milton. The menu options and the general layout of the room was also discussed. After further discussion it was noted that while the room in itself was fine in terms of size and acoustics, the actual location within the restaurant was not the most desirable. A couple options emerged:

- 1. To go back to the original room but enter into negotiations about paying for the room.
- 2. To look at any other alternatives.

While it was noted that it would be preferable to remain on the west coast in terms of alternatives, it would not necessarily be the guiding factor. President Kevin asked PP Mark to put together a survey in order to garner responses from those not present.

PR Director Morton's Presentation

Director Morton reviewed the PR goals for the year and commented on the merits of the achievements. He noted there has been more activity and interest in our Facebook Page as oppose to our Website. The press have been engaged in our events. PEE Morton stated the areas where goals have been difficult to meet and also the successes achieved thus far. In general, it was noted that the Club has been more visible to the public.


