HIGHLIGHTS FROM CLUB MEETING NOVEMBER 8th 2016

BINGO

The Rotary Club of Barbados West's annual Bingo night is scheduled for 12 December 2016. It is themed "50 for 50" in celebration of Barbados' 50th anniversary of independence. The cost per bingo card is \$50. The grand prize is \$50,000, with minimum guaranteed winnings of \$13,400. Opportunities are still available for sponsorship of the event which is managed by Rotarian Christopher Hoyte. This year's format represents an improvement on previous bingo nights. It is expected that upcoming editions of this event will continue to be enhanced along similar lines.

HOUSE REPAIR PROJECT

Past President David Huque provided an update on the progress of the House Repair Project. The subject of this year's project is a house occupied by an elderly gentleman located in Bank Hall, St. Michael, Barbados. It is a three-bedroom wooden house whose living, dining and kitchen areas are severely dilapidated. In particular, the flooring is in need of repair; the boarded walls on the south side of the house are rotted; and the roof needs to be replaced. The estimated cost of repairs, including materials, is \$14,000. Additional materials have been donated by the members of the Rotary Club of Barbados West to complete the refurnishing of the house.



2017 POLIO NATIONAL IMMUNIZATION DAY (NID)

National Immunization Day – India From the Desk of Nancy Barbee.

Dear Fellow Rotarians:

The purpose of this correspondence is to announce our trip to India to participate in the January 2017 Polio National Immunization Day (NID).

Attached are three documents that provides specific information about the trip, including a means of registering for the program and a tour application. Please fill out the application as soon as possible. After I receive your commitment, you'll begin receiving more specific information about our trip. Can't wait to begin. This will be a life changing experience.



Please feel free to share this information with the Rotarians and clubs in your District as soon as possible as we have a limited amount of space and expect this trip to be filled within the next week or two. Family and friends of Rotarians are welcome as well.

In 2012, India was removed from the list of polio endemic countries and in 2013 the entire Southeast Asia Region was declared Polio free. This does not mean it isn't still important for India to continue to immunize children and remain diligent in these efforts.

However, we are getting remarkably close to eradicating polio globally. Therefore, this might be one of the last opportunities we will have to organize a trip to India to participate in polio NID activities. This trip offers you and the Rotarians in your club and District an extraordinary opportunity to have an experience of a lifetime.

The following summarizes the key trip information.

Our group will travel to Delhi, India, where we visit the World Health Organization, UNICEF and the Polio Plus Office for Polio updates. We'll visit St. Stephen's Hospital where Dr. Matthew performs reconstructive surgeries on polio patients. Then we'll see some of the many sites around Old and New Delhi as time permits.

This trip also includes travel to Agra to visit the Taj Mahal. We'll fly to Kolkata to visit Mother Teresa's Mission of Charity, visit with Rotarians and see Rotary projects. Then we'll travel by bus to Dhanbad, my home in India (District 3250), where we will be hosted in Rotarian homes and see their many Rotary projects. We'll have our own project too.
